ORDINANCE NO. 2012- 11

AN ORDINANCE REQUESTING THAT THE CLERK OF CAMDEN COUNTY INCLUDE A PUBLIC QUESTION ON THE OFFICIAL BALLOT FOR THE NEXT GENERAL ELECTION IN THE BOROUGH OF BERLIN

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Borough of Berlin has determined it to be in the best interest of Berlin Borough to ascertain the sentiment of the legal voters of Berlin Borough to determine if the residents are in favor of establishing a free public library pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 40:54-1, *et seq.*, in the Borough of Berlin; and

WHEREAS, *N.J.S.A.* 19:47-1, *et seq.*, permits a municipality to adopt an Ordinance requesting that the County Clerk include a non-binding question or policy pertaining to the government of Berlin Borough or its internal affairs on the ballot for the next general election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Berlin, County of Camden, State of New Jersey as follows:

The Governing Body of Berlin Borough requests that the Clerk of Camden County print upon the official ballots for the next general election in Berlin Borough the following question:

Shall a free public library be established in the Borough of Berlin pursuant to Sections 40:54-1 to 40:54-29 of the Title "Municipalities and Counties of the Revised Statutes?"

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are, to the extent of such inconsistencies, hereby repealed.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage, adoption, and publication in the manner prescribed by law.
