

BOROUGH OF BERLIN
ORDINANCE NO. 2014-01
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2013-01 SUPPLEMENTING
CHAPTER 62 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BERLIN ENTITLED
“SALARIES”

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF
BERLIN, CAMDEN COUNTY, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 3. Chapter 62, subsection 3, of the code of the Borough of Berlin is hereby amended to read as follows:

Said salaries shall be effective, subject to the provisions of statute referred to, as of January 1, 2014. Said salaries shall be paid at the time and in the same manner as may hereafter be determined by the Borough Council of the Borough of Berlin.

SECTION 4. Chapter 62, subsection 5, of the Code of the Borough of Berlin is hereby amended to read as follows:

A. The annual salaries of the following contractual employees of the Borough of Berlin hereinafter named be and the same are hereby fixed, effective January 1, 2014, as follows:

SECTION 5. Chapter 62, subsection 8, of the Code of the Borough of Berlin is amended to read as follows: "The salaries and wages specified herein shall take effect as of January 1, 2014.

SECTION 7. All ordinances or part of ordinances, which are inconsistent with the provisions hereof, are, to extent of such inconsistencies, hereby replaced.

SECTION 8. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication as provided by law, and the salary schedule shall continue in effect, beginning of January 1, 2014 unless otherwise provided by law.
