

AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING CHAPTER 86 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BERLIN, ENTITLED AMUSEMENT DEVICES

WHEREAS, the Borough of Berlin ("Borough") is a municipal entity organized and existing under the laws of the State of New Jersey and located in Camden County; and WHEREAS, the Borough's Mayor and Council believes it to be in the best public interest and welfare to delete an archaic provision of the Code of the Borough of Berlin as it relates to Amusement Devices.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of

Berlin, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:


Section 1: Chapter 86 of the Code of the Borough of Berlin is hereby rescinded in its entirety.

Section 2: All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such subdivision, clause or provision and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
