ORDINANCE NO. 2016-09
**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BERLIN MODIFYING
THE FEES OF THE BERLIN COMMUNITY CENTER USE**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Berlin is a municipal entity organized and existing under the laws of the State of New Jersey and located in Camden County; and

WHEREAS, the Borough seeks to amend its fee schedule for use of the Berlin Community Center; and

WHEREAS, it is determined that said action is in the best interest of the taxpayers, citizens and residents of the Borough of Berlin.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough of the Borough of Berlin, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 8, §8-2 A., B. and C. of the Code of the Borough of Berlin shall hereby be amended as follows:

Section 1: §8-2 Fee schedule; clean; insurance.

The fees for use of the Berlin Community Center are as follows:

A. Banquet facility (exclusive use of entire Community Center for private events).

(1) Fees.

(a) Use fee for Berlin Residents: \$175 for two hours (minimum charge).

(b) Use fee for Berlin Residents: \$350 for four hours, each additional hour \$50.

(c) Use fee for nonresidents: \$225 for two hours (minimum charge).

(d) Use fee for nonresidents: \$450 for four hours, each additional hour \$50.

(d) Security Deposit: \$100

(e) Attendant fee: \$15 per hour.

B. Conference rooms (per room).

(1) Nonprofit Berlin Borough organizations: no charge for up to 8 hours per week; \$25 per hour for each hour in excess of 8 hours. Organizations are permitted use of the conference rooms and gymnasium without charge for a total of 8 hours per week combined.

(2) All other Berlin residents: \$25.

(3) All other organizations/non-residents: \$50.

(4) Surcharge for food in conference room: \$50.

C. Gymnasium (fee applies to one half of gymnasium, either blue or yellow side).


- (1) Nonprofit Berlin Borough organizations: no charge for up to 8 hours per week; \$25 per hour for each hour in excess of 8 hours. Organizations are permitted use of the conference rooms and gymnasium without charge for a total of 8 hours per week combined.
- (2) All other Berlin residents: \$25.
- (3) All other organizations/non-residents: \$50.
- (4) Security deposit: \$100 for use of one half of gymnasium and \$150 for use of full gymnasium.

Section 2: All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.


Section 3: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such subdivision, clause or provision and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.


