ORDINANCE NO. 2018-06

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 52, ARTICLE II, OFF-DUTY EMPLOYMENT,
SPECIFICALLY §51-19, PAYMENT REQUIREMENT OF THE CODE OF THE
BOROUGH OF BERLIN, COUNTY OF CAMDEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

WHEREAS, Chapter 52, Article II, Off-Duty Employment, specifically §51-19, Payment Requirement, set forth certain fees and administrative costs charged by the Borough of Berlin for utilization of personnel and equipment within the Berlin Borough Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Borough Counsel believe it to be in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Borough of Berlin to make certain modifications and amendments to aforesaid Ordinance set forth in the Code of the Borough of Berlin.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Berlin as follows:

Section 1: Chapter 52, Article II, Off-Duty Employment, specifically §51-19 B. Payment requirement, shall be amended as follows:

§52.19 B. Contractors, other government agencies, or other business or civic instrumentalities requiring extra police services resulting in the hiring of Borough police officers for off-duty employment shall be charged pursuant to the following schedule:

(1) Traffic Control (defined as outdoor activity): \$65.00 per hour, per full-time police officer, \$15.00 per patrol car, per day, plus a \$15.00 per hour administrative fee.

(2) Security Duties (defined as indoor activity): \$60.00 per hour, per full-time police officer, plus a \$10.00 per hour administrative fee.


(3) County Traffic Duties (defined a work requested by or through the County of Camden): \$58.00 per hour, per full-time police officer, paid out of the current maximum County reimbursement of \$67.00, the balance of the funds to be paid toward patrol car usage fees and administrative fees. Any and all future County increases shall be paid toward patrol car usage fees and administrative fees.

Section 2: All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such subdivision, clause or provision and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
