## WORKSHOP MEETING MINUTES

Solicitor Howard Long was present via phone.

Mayor Miller had questions regarding the use of the Community Center for outside groups. Since the center is currently being rented by the school, there should be no other uses permitted at this time.

Councilmember Simone commented on the DPW and how hard they have been working regarding snow removal. He also commented on the candidates interviewed for the Deputy Clerk/Administrative Assistant position.

Council President mention the need for an Executive Session to further discuss the potential hiring of the Deputy Clerk and the appointment of a Registrar.

Councilmember Pearce commented that he has had good conversations with various departments and personnel regarding Public Safety issues.


Councilmember Miller had comments regarding the Construction office related to issuing and waiving permits.
